7	SS	30	<p>Award 8 marks if writes any four points-Always use the footpath while walking. Ensure that one keeps away from the edge of the road to avoid getting knocked down by a vehicle. One has to walk in a single file on the extreme edge of the road facing on coming vehicles and thus avoid getting hurt, if there is no footpath. Watch out for pot holes, open drains, fruit/vegetable peels. Never accept rides from strangers; it could be dangerous for you, you might be kidnapped or harmed at times. Always use zebra crossing while crossing the road. If zebra crossing is not available, choose a safe place where traffic is visible from both sides. Avoid crossing at a blind curve. Never walk on railway tracks. Always use over-bridge. If there is no such over-bridge, wait for the gate or barrier to open to cross it.
